	A.	Safety Whistles – Discussion and possible action to ordering safety whistles for the CATS walk to hand out as promo gifts. Whistles can be ordered from 4imprint, 350 whistles, with setup and shipping come to \$463.61. Following is the breakdown for the order: \$346.50 (whistles), \$60 (setup), \$18.49 shipping & \$38.62 (tax).
