HOM 2020 09 01: the Encino Neighborhood Council Homeless Committee requests that Councilman Paul Koretz, CD 5, Council president Nury Martinez CD 6, and Councilman David Ryu (CD4) work with the Encino and adjacent Neighborhood Councils to investigate a location for a pallet shelter or similar community adjacent to and East of the Tillman Sanitation Plant, and also an RV Safe Parking location on Oxnard Street adjacent to the 405 Freeway.
