- A. **Motion:** ENC approves additional \$100 for one year of email hosting.
- B. **Motion:** ENC approves payment of \$450.00 to AAA Rents & Events for emergency sound engineering services rendered at Encino Fest due to equipment failure, and a flat gratuity of \$150.00 to stage and table setup personnel for support provided under the same emergency conditions, for a total authorized expenditure of \$600.00 to be paid from the ENC event budget in accordance with City funding procedures.
- C. **Motion:** ENC approves payment of \$167.50 to O Lock Smith for emergency locksmith services rendered at Encino Park during Encino Fest. Services consisted of cutting a bolt lock on the power box due to the absence of an available key from the Encino Community Center and LA Recreation and Parks, which was required to restore power to the sound system and stage. To be paid from the ENC event budget in accordance with City funding procedures.

A legislative body that does not provide a timed public comment period, but takes public comment separately on each agenda item, shall allow a reasonable amount of time per agenda item to allow public members the opportunity to provide public comment, including time for members of the public to register pursuant to paragraph (5), or otherwise be recognized for the purpose of providing public comment. **California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(6)(B)**.
