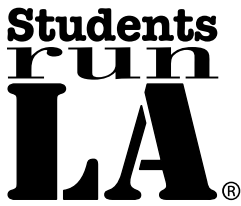

Students Run LA, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, is proudly known for challenging underserved secondary students to experience the benefits of goal-setting, character development, adult mentoring, and improving their overall health by providing them with a truly life-changing experience: The training for and completion of the Los Angeles Marathon!
